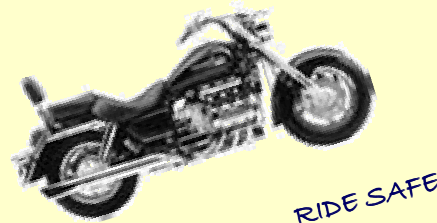

RIDER EDUCATION



Subject: Group Riding with "Daffy Don"

It's a beautiful day and we are getting ready to head out to a great ride destination. We have ridden many of the roads on this route and know most of the riders who will be riding with us. We are waiting for one more rider who called and said he was on the way. We will have our rider meeting and everyone will know what to expect regarding break/gas stops and where we will be having lunch.

Our departure time is rapidly approaching and the good news is our new rider has just arrived. The bad news is that a "Daffy Don" has joined the group. A "Daffy Don" is easier to recognize than to deal with. The tell-tale signs are many and in short order can be a problem for the whole group. When you are starting your engines, Daffy will probably still be chatting with the chickie babe in the ice cream store. While everyone else is mounting up, "Daffy Don" has put on his gloves and then removed them to put on his helmet. The same happens again when he realizes he has his helmet and gloves on and his keys are in his pocket. Again, off come the gloves. Meanwhile everyone else has their engine running and looking around to see what's hold up the departure.

During the ride, you can expect "Daffy" to constantly be drifting over into the wrong track with the following riders all doing the line samba trying to re-establish the staggered formation. If we know "Daffy", he will drop back just enough to allow a following car to pass and cause the last 3 riders to miss the green light. And, of course, "Daffy" will expect you to find a gas station on a moments notice, because he only fills up after his bike has gone on reserve, or the red light comes on, and that won't occur for another 5 miles. Don't think you can ignore him-he'll roar up through the formation to tell you when he's ready!

My suggestion for ride Captains who think they may be blessed with a "DAFFY", is to make it clear at the rider's meeting that you expect everyone to conform to the group. Explain your expectations for the ride, along with any rules you think would help. Describe where the group will be stopping and where and when the ride is expected to end. Make it clear that when the group stops for fuel, everyone is expected to top up their tanks and drain their bladders! When it's time to leave, GO!

The ride leader should make it clear that when he sets the departure time that is when the break ends and that you weren't kidding! GO!

If "Daffy" is running round in circles at departure time, GO!

If "Daffy" continues running round in circles at the next stop, when the group is ready to go, GO!

Don't let the "Daffys" of the world ruin the ride for everyone else.

Sometimes the ride leader needs to be the bad guy. The rest of the group will appreciate it.

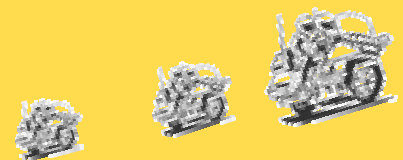

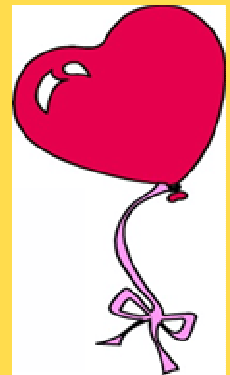

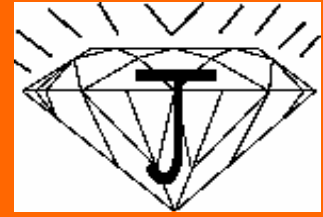
